Parent & Student Production/Audition Information Meetings (see Fridge File)

YPT provides detailed information about involvement in productions so that families can make an informed decision before committing to a production. Meetings are scheduled prior to auditions for each production. Two meetings are convened - one in an afternoon and one in the evening - you need to attend one meeting only. Attendance at a Production Audition/Information Meeting is an **audition eligibility requirement**.

YPT Theatre School - things to remember:

- wear comfortable clothing, a YPT t-shirt and soft-soled enclosed shoes - no "short shorts"!
- bring a bottle of water;
- go to the bathroom before class
- only enrolled students are permitted in classrooms, ie. no guests or visitors allowed
- for security purposes, the gate at HSPA is locked during classes. Contact the YPT Office if the gate is locked when you need to enter the grounds
- after classes, a tutor will wait with students for 10 minutes before contacting parents; a late pick up fee applies if students are not picked up on time
- YPT T-shirts are available at the Office (\$20.00ea)

Spotlight

YPT Policies: keeping you up-to-date

- *Audition Policy:* eligibility criteria include attendance at a Production/Audition Information Meeting, 75% attendance record in Theatre School classes, appropriate behavior and participation in classes, and age and experience required for the role.
- *Theatre School Attendance Policy:* to maintain a place in class, students must maintain 75% attendance and appropriate participation in classes
- *Leave of absence* from Theatre School classes may be approved for family holidays and prolonged illnesses - it will not be approved for sport or other weekly commitments.
- *YPT Dress Code:* students wear a YPT logo black T-shirt to classes, auditions and program photos; thongs or sandals are permitted to be worn to classes or rehearsals; no "short" shorts at any time
- *Theatre School Refund Policy:* unless exceptional circumstances are demonstrated, fees are not refunded after the first three classes
- *Associate Student Membership Policy:* Year 12 students may apply for Associate Membership. Contact the Office for details.
- *Theatre School Trainee Tutors:* Year 11/12 students interested in Tutor positions may submit applications.
- *Photography Policy:* parents are not permitted to take photos or to film students engaged in YPT activities
- *Working with Children policy:* YPT employees (above the age of 18 years) and all volunteers are required to obtain a Working with Children Clearance (WWCC).
- *Safety Policy:* shoes are to be worn in the Theatre at all times; student in productions, parents, volunteers and employees are to sign in/out each time they enter and exit the buildings

Sparkle and Shine Concert

Reuben Sutherland was a much loved member of the YPT community. He was tragically killed on 30 March 2015 as he crossed the road after getting off the school bus. He was 12 years old. As the YPT community is committed to remembering this enthusiastic and generous hearted young man, with the agreement of his family, the *YPT Remembers Reuben Scholarship* was established. The *Sparkle and Shine Concert* supports the scholarship. Performances are on 27 and 29 April.

Food Rules

No Chocolate for Cast Members

Chocolate coats the throat and effects voice production; it also creates oily, sometimes permanent, marks on costume. Chocolate is NOT to be eaten by cast wearing costume; chocolate is NOT permitted in Dressing Rooms.

Cans of Drinks

Cans of drink are NOT permitted in the Dressing Rooms; bottles with lids and poppa type drinks are permitted. *Protecting Costume*

Cast must cover their costume before they eat; a large shirt, apron or other covering is appropriate.

Hot Food

Takeaway type hot food is NOT permitted in the Auditorium or the Foyer; hot food may be eaten in the Green Room and the Courtyard; hot food wrappings are to be deposited in the bins in the Courtyard (not in internal garbage bins where they will encourage cockroaches).

YPT Code

- **Communication:** open, respectful communication is expected of all YPT members; please consider the impact of your conversation on the people around you.
- **Dealing with issues:** the point of contact in relation to successes/issues/problems is the person or people who have responsibility for specified duties, ie the set construction team, the wardrobe coordinator, the principal of the theatre school, etc; if you find it awkward to discuss things with that person, please either speak to the people in the Office or email to let us know of your concerns - comments made behind the scenes will not solve the problem, are unhelpful and can be disruptive.
- **Volunteer run organisation:** YPT operates 12 months a year on the work of a small band of volunteers; classes and productions run according to a "formula" which has been developed over many years; if you want to have input to the "formula", come to the monthly General Meetings; if you want to join the small band of workers, please let us know as we would be grateful for your assistance
- **Succession Planning:** often in organisations it looks like the jobs are all "tied up" or it is a *closed shop*. This is far from the truth at YPT – we need new people to come to meetings, to share their fresh ideas and ways of doing business and to help sustain this amazing organisation into the future. If you are interested, please let us know.

Carlo Colodi's traditional tale about a marionette that comes to life after learning to be brave, faithful and truthful has been captivating children for centuries. Come and join Pinocchio, his cricket friend, Claudius, the suave con-artist Ignatius, his unfortunate accomplice Hiccup and a host of other colourful and fun characters. This story was adapted by William Ford for Young People's Theatre. Suitable for all ages.

- **Elf Jr. (18 performances)**

Communication - keeping the YPT community in the loop

YPT communicates via this newsletter, Spotlight, email, webpage, facebook and skoolbag. We devote time to maintaining multiple methods of communication in an attempt to meet the needs of a diverse range of families.

- **in person:** Office Hours are 9.00 to 1.00pm Saturday
- **phone**
 - phones in the YPT Office do not take messages and, as YPT is run by volunteers, often there is no one to take your calls; you will always get a response to an email
- **email**
 - email is the most significant form of communication at YPT;
 - an email address is recorded for each YPT student and adult member
 - an email distribution list is created for each Theatre School class, ie. 29 individual class lists,
 - an email distribution list is created for each and every production, ie, every cast member in a production is included in a cast list
 - If you change your email address, please let us know!
 - If you find that you are not receiving occasional emails from YPT, please check your spam/junk folder as, if you have not added ypt@ypt.org.au, boxoffice@ypt.org.au, school@ypt.org.au, productions@ypt.org.au to your Contacts, your system may be filing YPT emails as junk/spam.
- **Website (updated site available soon)**

The YPT webpage contains background and policy information for families. The main tabs on the webpage are (i) Theatre School and (ii) Theatre Company. These are the 2 essential elements of YPT, ie students and productions.

YPT facebook can be accessed through the YPT website. Facebook is used to promote YPT productions, celebrate our achievements and maintain a presence in the Newcastle theatre community.
- **Spotlight**
 - is published once a term. It is for people who prefer a hard copy of messages and for those who like to display important notices on the family fridge

Book of Mormon - Lyric Theatre: July 2018

Lindsay Street Players (YPT) Coach Trip!!

The Book of Mormon follows two young missionaries who are sent to Uganda to try to convert citizens to the Mormon religion. One missionary, Elder Price, is an enthusiastic go-getter with a strong dedication to his faith, while his partner, Elder Cunningham, is a socially awkward but well-meaning nerd whose tendency to embroider the truth soon lands him in trouble. Upon their arrival in Africa, Elders Price and Cunningham learn that in a society plagued by AIDS, poverty and violence, a successful mission may not be as easy as they expected.

A YPT bus trip has been organised to see *Book of Mormon* at Sydney's Lyric Theatre in July. Older students, adult members and supporters are invited to purchase tickets to come on the bus trip. The price of \$145.00 covers the bus trip & A reserve tickets. Some fund raising activities will happen on the bus along the way, eg. lucky seat prizes, etc, so bring some small change with you! There will be plenty of time to have a stroll around Star City and to get lunch before show time.
